Project Description:

Algoma Power Inc. (API) is a Licenced Electrical Distributor which distributes reliable power to customers in the Algoma district, from Marion Lake to west of Thessalon including the Dubreuilville Area. API has 12,000 customers and more than 1,800 kilometers of distribution lines in an area that covers over 14,000 square kilometers.

PowerNorth is a local Northern Ontario construction company specializing in High Voltage Construction. Algoma Power (the Owner) has contracted PowerNorth to re route and re-build the existing 44 kV (44,000 volt) power line from Goudreau to the new Alamos and Argonaut Mines. The upgrade will provide additional power to the Alamos Gold's Island Gold Mine for the proposed expansion of its existing mining operations and provide service to Argonaut's proposed Magino Mine. The relocation will shift a section of the No. 4 Circuit out of its existing right-of-way, placing it along a new right-of-way to avoid Magino's proposed open pit.
