YOUR STEP BY STEP GUIDE TO THE EASEMENT PROCESS

OVERVIEW

Q. *Why does API need an Easement?*
A. API requires an Easement to ensure the safe and reliable delivery of power to you and your neighbours.

Q. *What is an Easement?*
A. An Easement is a legal agreement with API that allows us to use and maintain a strip of property as a corridor to provide safe and reliable power to you.

Q. *Am I selling my property to API?*
A. No. The property in question still remains in your name. The agreement and location of the strip is registered on property title.

Q. *Can't I just agree? Why do we have to go through a legal process?*
A. An agreement with a land owner does not protect the special relationship with the subject property in the event that the land changes ownership.

PROCEDURE

1. You, as the land owner, sign an **AGREEMENT TO GRANT AND TRANSFER AN EASEMENT AND PERMISSION FOR IMMEDIATE ENTRY.**



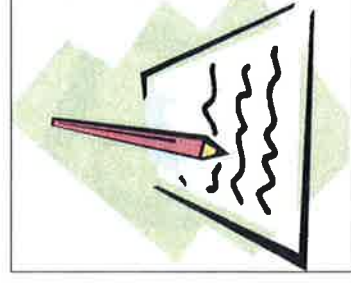
This allows API to begin work on your property. It also allows a land surveyor to enter onto the property in order to conduct a land survey.



2. The necessary field work is completed by API.



3. The land surveyor will conduct the land survey, prepare a plan showing the area of the easement and register it at the land titles office.



4. Legal documents to register the easement are prepared by our API's lawyer.
